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AASA Online Permit Application Process

Please note that the preferred timeframe for this process is six months for Tarmac Rally events, and two months for all other events

Race Events:	National, State or Club level events
Non-Race Events:	Extreme Events, Burnouts, Drifting (including practice), Go to Whoa, Drag Racing, Power Skids, Sprints, Single or Multi Car Club Lap Dash, Ride/Corporate Day, Car Show/Show & Shine, Photo/Film Shoot, Come & Try/Fun Day, Driver Training, Motorkhana, Autokhana/Khanacross, Ride-on Mower Racing, Hill Climb, Touring Road Events.
Rally Events:	Tarmac, Gravel, Rallysprints
Off Road Racing Events:	National, State or Club level events, Practice

Step 1: **Ensure that you have read the AASA Terms & Conditions – Permits**
Complete the online application form for the relevant permit and event types.
Provide a copy of the supplementary regulations, entry form and any other required documents in word format for approval by AASA. Some supplementary regulation templates are available at www.aasa.com.au

Step 2: Once the application and any other documents are approved, an invoice will be issued to the organiser by AASA, (unless payment was made on application) and the permit number provided.

Step 3: Ensure that you provide AASA a copy of any further regulations and bulletins. This may be sent it after the event if necessary.

Step 4: After payment is received and all documents are approved, your permit will be issued.

Step 5: Post Event paperwork needs to be returned to AASA office within 7 days of the event (preferred email return to info@aasa.com.au)
